HERBSTER COMMUNITY CLUB SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The Scholarship Fund is open to Town of Clover and other graduating seniors attending South Shore High School (SSHS), and also to homeschooled students from the South Shore School District, if they plan to pursue any undergraduate course of study at an accredited two or four year college, university, or technical college. The Herbster Community Club (HCC) will not pay for tuition to an exclusive online school. Students who have opted out of the South Shore School District to attend another district will not be considered.

The Scholarship Fund is open to any former SSHS students and past scholarship recipients who need help to finish their education. Recipients may reapply for scholarship on a yearly basis. Candidates from the Town of Clover shall be given first consideration, providing they meet all qualifications. If there are no qualifying applications from the Town of Clover, the award may be given to any other applicant from the South Shore School District. Graduating SSHS seniors have priority.

Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and be either accepted at the school of their choice, be enrolled by the second semester following graduation, or have successfully completed one semester at their school prior to receiving the scholarship. Final determination of the scholarship recipient shall be subject to review and approval by the HCC Scholarship Committee and approved by the HCC Executive Committee. If there is a change in institution, the recipient has to appeal to the HCC Scholarship Committee.

The selection process is based on:

- 1. Graduating SSHS Town of Clover seniors have priority
- 2. Applicant's demonstration of potential success in their chosen course of study
- 3. Minimum GPA of 3.0
- 4. Applicant's financial needs
- 5. Letter of recommendation from a school staff member, teacher or a community member who knows the applicant

Scholarship funds will be paid directly by the HCC Treasurer to the recipient's school and shall be applied to registration, books, supplies and other related instructional expenses. The payout shall be given after proof of grades from first semester and proof of enrollment in the next semester are received and submitted to the HCC Scholarship Committee for review. These items need to be submitted to the HCC Scholarship Committee no later than February 1.
